

# Youngster's 70lb-plus mixed bag

THIS colourful mixed bag of fish was caught by nine-year-old George Hunt at Woodside Fishery.

George fed softened 6mm pellets and sweetcorn using a cupping kit at 6m and fished a single grain of corn over the top to catch more than 70lb of carp, goldfish, roach and skimmers from the popular Shropshire venue.

Fishing alongside his dad, Ashley, George used a 4x12 float, 0.15mm mainline to a 0.12mm hooklength and a size 16 Maver Invincible CS23 hook.

### Groundbait Method feeder for carp and skimmers



Now the temperature has dropped, groundbait will start to get more bites compared to pellets fished around the Method feeder. Try a mix of micro pellets and groundbait around your feeder, but switch to fishing with just groundbait when it gets colder. The best way to mould this around your feeder is to use a Method mould. There are several types available – pick one that matches your feeder for the best results.

**1** Part-fill the mould with groundbait and pellets. Place your hook and hookbait on top.

**2** Add more groundbait and pellets until it is full to the top.

**3** Press your feeder into the mould to compact the bait.

**4** Squeeze the mould to release the feeder (some moulds have a push-button release). Your feeder is now perfectly loaded with groundbait and pellets.
